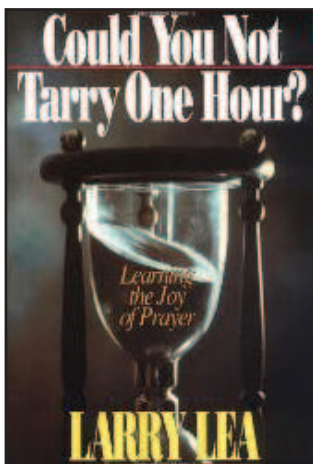


Foundations
