

ILLNESS POLICY

It is a priority that we maintain a safe and healthy environment for your child as well as our staff members and volunteers. With this in mind, if your child is not feeling well, please do not allow them to participate in Calvary Kids or Play Zone activities. For your convenience, we have listed our illness policy below.

- Please do not bring your child to Calvary Kids or Play Zone if they display any of the following symptoms and/or illnesses: temperature of 100 degrees or greater, cloudy drainage from nose, questionable rashes, coughing, diarrhea, impetigo, active chicken pox, measles, mumps, conjunctivitis (pink eye).
- Children being treated with antibiotics must be on the prescription at least 24 hours before re turning to Calvary Kids or Calvary Play Zone.
- Children with allergies often have clear drainage from their nose. Please inform your child's teacher if he/she suffers from allergies.
- No medication can be given to any child by Calvary Kids or Play Zone staff members or volunteers.
- If your child develops a fever or other symptoms of illness while in our care, you will be notified immediately by a staff member to pick-up your child from Calvary Kids or Play Zone.
