



Sermon Discussion Guide - April 26, 2025
Thy Kingdom Come - Worry

- 1. Group exercise: give everyone a pile of notecards, pieces of paper or better yet, a stack of post-it notes and have them list out as many things as possible that people worry about in 30 seconds. Tell them to write fast! Then have the group go through their answers and group their answers by theme. You will want to organize them on a table (or a wall if using post-its).**
 - *What are the major themes that people most worry about?*
- 2. Read Matthew 6:24-34**
 - *Are there any particular verses that jump out to you? Why?*
- 3. Why does the idea of “serving two masters” drive us to worry?**
- 4. Pastor Michael said “It’s easy to call on Jesus as Savior, but it’s difficult to submit to Jesus as Lord.**
 - *Have you experienced this in your own life? Why is submission so hard? Is there something that you are struggling with submitting to Jesus right now?*
- 5. Read Phillipians 4:6-7. Consider this: “Worry without prayer paralyzes; worry turned into prayer produces peace.”**
 - *How does worry paralyze us?*
 - *What are some ways we can remember to pray when we feel worried?*
 - *How has prayer given you peace in the midst of a worry in your life?*
- 6. Read Habbakuk 3:17-18**
 - *Do you have this “even though...I will” type of faith? How can we grow and encourage each other to have this type of faith?*
- 7. How can your group pray for and support you in light of today’s discussion?**
