Thy Kingdom Come - Warning, Two Paths

- 1. What would be an example of choosing an easy path that ends up with poor outcomes, or choosing a hard path that ends up with good outcomes? Do you have an example from your own life with either of these?**
- 2. Read Matthew 7:13-14**
 - *What is your initial reaction to reading the passage?*
- 3. The first gate is described as wide, and the path easy.**
 - *Why do you think it is described this way?*
 - *The passage says that “many” people find this way to live. What type of people are in this group?*
- 4. The second gate is described as narrow, and the path hard.**
 - *Why do you think it is described this way?*
 - *Why do you think that only “few” find it?*
- 5. Why are hard things usually the best things for us?**
 - *Do you think that being a Christian is easy or hard? In what ways is it hard?*
 - *If you are not experiencing difficulty in your walk with Jesus, what do you think that means?*
 - *Describe a time in your faith when you had to walk a hard road, had to make some hard choices and it led to “life.”*
- 6. Read Matthew 11:28-30**
 - *What promise is here for those on the hard path? What are some practical things we can do to experience this?*
- 7. How can your group pray for and support you in light of today’s discussion?**
 - *Who are people you know that are on the easy road that you want your group to pray for?*
 - *Who are people you know who are on a particularly hard road right now in their faith and you want your group to pray for?*
