



Sermon Discussion Guide - March 8, 2025
The Great Commission

As we prepare for Easter, we are looking at our call to evangelism.

- 1. What comes to your mind when you think about evangelism? Is sharing the gospel or telling your personal story easy or difficult for you? Why?**
- 2. Read Matthew 28:18-20**
 - *What jumps out to you about these verses? Why is it important to remember Jesus' statement about His authority in light of His call to us to evangelize?*
- 3. Read Matthew 7:13-14**
 - *Think about your life before you became a Christian. How would you describe life on the wide, easy road? What caused you to get onto the narrow, hard road? Why do you think Jesus describes the road that leads to life narrow and hard?*
- 4. Read John 3:36 and Romans 5:9**
 - *What do these verses tell us that we are actually saved from?*
 - *How are we saved from the wrath of God? What does this mean about the work of Jesus on the cross?*
- 5. Pastor Mark challenged us about our concern for those who are under God's wrath:**
 - *Are you concerned enough to be careful in how we live around them?*
 - *Are you concerned enough to pray for them?*
 - *Are you concerned enough to see your life as a call to serve them in Jesus' name?*
 - *Are you concerned enough to enter into a spiritual conversation with them?*
 - *Which of these concerns are you motivated to do, and which one feels challenging for you?*
- 6. How can your group pray for and support you in light of today's discussion? Share with each other 1-2 people you know who don't know Jesus and pray for them, and pray for your concern for them to increase.**
