



**Sermon Discussion Guide - May 3, 2025**  
**Thy Kingdom Come - Judgement**

- 1. What are some bible verses that are most well known, even to non-Christians?**
  - *Have the group share their favorite bible verse or passage and why it is their favorite.*
  
- 2. Read Matthew 7:1-6**
  - *What is most challenging to you in this passage?*
  
- 3. Matthew 7:2 tells us “the warning” of judgement.**
  - *What are some negative ways our words can be measured?*
  - *What are some positive ways our words should be measured?*
  
- 4. Matthew 7:3-4 calls us to self-examination.**
  - *What do you think that Jesus is communicating when he talks about the “log” and the “speck” and who has which in their eye? Why is it hard for us to see the “logs” in our own eyes?*
  
- 5. Matthew 7:4-5 tells us the helpfulness of judgement.**
  - *We can’t rightly confront someone about something that we are blind to in our own selves. Verse 5 says that when we remove the log from our eye, we can ‘see clearly’ to take the speck out of another’s eye. How do our “logs” blur or block our vision?*
  - *The process for judgement is: 1) get your log out; 2) go to a person personally in love; 3) go with someone else if they reject you; 4) go to the church if they continue to not listen. Have you ever had to go through this process? How did it go? What is most difficult about this process?*
  
- 6. Matthew 7:6 challenges us in how we communicate to non-Christians.**
  - *What are some ways we can evangelize without being judgemental?*
  - *How can you not get hurt, argue or retaliate when attacked by a non-Christian?*
  
- 7. How can your group pray for and support you in light of today’s discussion?**
